# Pleasanton Blairgowrie Fergus Sister City Organization

## History

A dedicated group whose common desire was to promote Scottish heritage, culture, and customs formed the Pleasanton Blairgowrie Sister City Organization. Blairgowrie was selected for “twinning” in May 1994 and formally endorsed by the Pleasanton City Council in June of that year. The first general meeting was held in July with 40 members present. Fergus, which was already a sister city to Blairgowrie, officially “twinned” with Pleasanton in January 2001 and we became Pleasanton Blairgowrie Fergus Sister City Organization (PBFSCO).

## Mission

The Pleasanton Blairgowrie Fergus Sister City Organization (PBFSCO) promotes understanding and friendship amongst the citizens of Pleasanton, Blairgowrie, and Fergus and their respective regions; and encourages cooperation and understanding at all levels of the communities on an ongoing basis.
