A dedicated group whose common desire was to promote Scottish heritage, culture, and customs formed the Pleasanton Blairgowrie Sister City Organization. Blairgowrie was selected for "twinning" in May 1994 and formally endorsed by the Pleasanton City Council in June. The first general membership meeting was held in July with 40 members present. Fergus, which was already a sister city to Blairgowrie, officially "twinned" with Pleasanton in January 2001 and we became the Pleasanton Blairgowrie Fergus Sister City Organization (PBFSCO). Today, with over 100 members, the organization continues to grow.

Located approximately 45 miles north of Edinburgh in Perthshire District. Population of the region is 120,000 which is similar to that of the Tri-Valley.

fergus ...

Located one hour to the west of Toronto, Canada, Fergus was first settled by people from the Blairgowrie area.
